Pull Tabs for the House That Love Bult- District Wide Service Project

- 1. We are asking clubs to participate in a district wide project to benefit the Ronald McDonald House in Baltimore.
- 2. As you know childhood cancer is one of our global causes and some of the children staying at Ronald McDonald House have been diagnosed with cancer along with other chronic illnesses.
- 3. We will be collecting pull-tabs off soda, soup, and food cans.
- 4. The pull tabs will be collected beginning in November and running until at least the February cabinet meeting.
- 5. Please bring your collections to the next cabinet meeting or else give them to your zone chair.
- 6. The pull tabs will then be taken to the McDonald House in Baltimore

Once delivered, the pull-tabs will then be taken to a local recycling center, where they are weighed and redeemed for cash per pound. This money is used to purchase gas for their shuttles that take families to and from area hospitals. It has been a helpful fundraiser for the House. Besides benefiting the families of RMH, collecting pull-tabs for recycling is an environmentally friendly practice as well! One of International President Dr. Patti Hill's global priorities is creating a cleaner greener environment.
